BA (Hons) in Home Economics and Business

The BA (Hons) in Home Economics and Business at Munster Technological University is a 3-year programme which supports graduates to gain advanced home economics and business knowledge and skills.

The Home Economics discipline areas include: food studies (including culinary skills; nutrition and food science); textiles, fashion and design; family resource management; home design; and social studies.

The Business discipline requires students to develop knowledge in areas such as entrepreneurship, international business, management, accounting, economics, and human resource management.

There will also be modules in Education which will introduce students to education studies, and will allow students to prepare for teaching through examination and reflection, on teaching and learning, planning and assessment. Students will also get the opportunity to engage in micro teaching sessions, and undertake a short placement working with a Home Economics teacher.



Progression to PME Post-Primary Teaching Qualification

Graduates who achieve a minimum of Second Class Honours Grade 2 in the BA (Hons) in Home Economics and Business at MTU will automatically be offered a place on the Professional Master of Education (PME) post-primary in the School of Education, University College Cork (UCC) through a 'protected places pathway'.

Completion of both programmes (3-year BA (Hons) Home Economics and Business in MTU and 2-year PME in UCC) allows graduates to meet all Teaching Council requirements to teach both Home Economics and Business to Leaving Certificate level in Irish second-level schools.
